The preparation and presentation for each topic will reflect their development of these skills. Simple presentations and an understanding of the topics, rather than reading from information, is desirable. Each week there will be a topic usually based on aspects of Level 2 curriculum. Our major Integrated Topic from Week 1 is **Lights, Camera, Action**.

This term the focus for Chatterboxing will be presentation, eye contact and voice projection. Please encourage your child to prepare and perhaps even practise speaking about his/her item. Your child will be familiar with the day on which their Chatterboxing occurs.
